## Rules of the Game:

- (1) **Late Registrations** : Received after Jan 29<sup>st</sup> will incur a \$10 admin charge, after Feb 12<sup>th</sup> will incur a \$20 admin charge.
- (2) **Refunds** : Full refunds will be given up to Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2010, after that date a 50% refund will be given
- (3) The event is not suitable for those under the age of 16, or for raw novices – ***you must have done some paddling.***
- (4) The Sunday on-the-water sessions are not suitable for a sit-on-top of less than 4.1m.
- (5) We can't hire you a kayak & gear, but we can arrange for a local outfitter to do so –website for details (\$35 for Sunday)
- (6) **You agree to abide by the safety rules set out by the Coastbusters organizing committee.**
- (7) **We work very hard to make this event safe – but you participate at your own risk.**
